HAVE YOU HAD YOUR SKIN CHECKED LATELY?

Annual skin checks with an experienced melanographer, dermatologist or trained general practitioner will give you the best chance of catching suspicious

spots or moles early when they're most treatable.

South Coast Medical are fortunate to have trained general practitioners specialising in skin checks at the Dromana, Capel Sound and Rye clinics. In addition, the Rye clinic is MoleMap licensed with a trained melanographer on site to provide full body checks with images for comparison in later years.
